



## Moon Folklore Card Stack

SAVE OFTEN AS YOU WORK!!

Each student (or group) will make one card for the stack. The card will include your picture of the moon, information you learned about moon folklore in your country, a map of that country (optional) and your name.

### Instructions:

1. Select **New Stack** from the Menu screen.  
*Untitled Card 1* will be at the top of the screen.
2. It is a good idea to name and save the file at this time. Select **File > Save Stack As**.  
Open the appropriate folder in which you save your work.  
Name the file with your last name (or group name) and save the file by clicking on the **Save** button. From this point on you can just select **Save Stack**.
3. Click on **Tools** and drag the **Toolbox** to the desktop. It will remain visible for selecting tools to create the card.
4. Click on **Colors** and drag the **Color Box** to the desktop. It will remain visible for changing colors.
5. Click the **Paint Can** and select a color from the **Color Box**. Click inside the card on the screen. Your screen should now be that color.
6. Put your picture of the moon on your card. See Adding Picture directions below.
7. To add text click on the **T** in the **Toolbox**. Select **Options > Text Style**, to change color or font styles.
8. Add a **Button** to move to the next card. Select **Objects > Add a Button**. From the **Button Appearance Screen** select a shape for the button from **Type**. Type a name, (Go, Next, etc.). Select **Icon** to choose an Icon. Clicking on a color box changes the background color and name color. Make sure the X's are marked beside **Show Name**, **Show Icon**, and **Highlight**. Click **OK**.

9. The button will appear in the middle of the screen enclosed within the **Arrow tool**. Click and drag it to the desired position on your card. Click out of the button when properly placed.
10. When the **Actions** menu appears, select **Next Card**.
11. Select a **Transition** movement from the Transition menu and select a speed. Medium or slow is best. Preview the Transition and Speed before you finish. Click **OK**.

### **Adding a picture to Your Card**

1. Locate a picture on the Internet, or in another program.
2. Highlight the picture.
3. Right click on the picture and select **Copy**.
4. Navigate to your HyperStudio card.
5. On the menu select **Edit > Paste** your picture.
6. Click on the picture and drag to the desired location and/or resize as necessary.
