- Born on August 5, 1930.
- Developed an interest in flying at an early age. His curiosity about airplanes was aroused at age two when his father took him to the National Air Races in Cleveland, Ohio.
- Graduated from Blume High School in Wapakoneta, Ohio, in 1947.
- Was one of the nine astronauts in the second group of astronauts to be chosen.
- On July 16, 1969, Armstrong, Michael Collins and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin began their trip to the moon.
- Became the second man to walk on the moon.
- On July 20, 1969, at 10:56 P.M. EDT became the first man to walk on the moon.
