

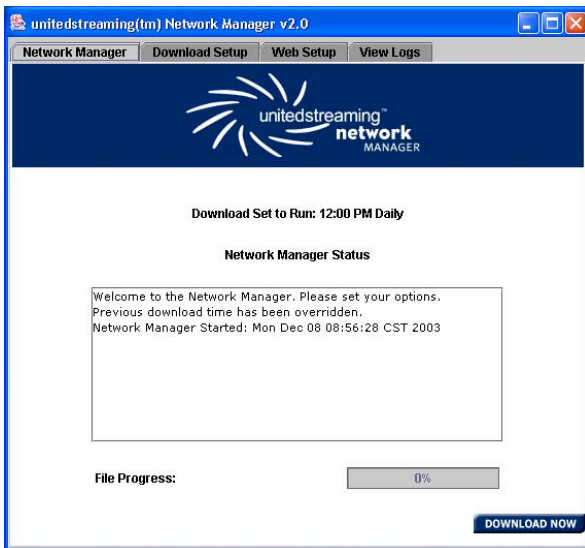


Network Manager

The *unitedstreaming* Network Manager allows you to download videos overnight and provide access to videos stored on your network through the *unitedstreaming* interface.

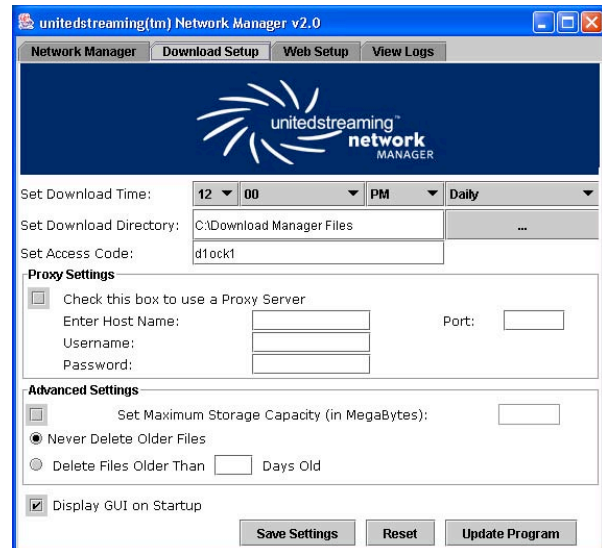
Users of *unitedstreaming* will have the ability to select videos and schedule them to be downloaded during off-peak Internet hours. An administrator of the Network Manager schedules the time and days for the application to begin transferring videos. For example, a teacher will select a video clip to be downloaded to the local server, at 7pm the Network Manager will begin transferring the video, by the next day the teacher will have the video available on the local server.

Features and Benefits:



- Utilize Internet bandwidth during off-peak hours. The Network Manager can download videos at night when the usage of the Internet tends to be much lower.
- Allows for live streaming and downloading during the day without using your Internet bandwidth.
- Facilitate the sharing of videos between teachers and students and eliminate the possibility of downloading the same video more than once.
- Self-sufficient application that requires minimal management.

- Limit amount space allowed for downloads. For example, limit space available to 20 GB of videos. Auto-cleanup routines are available for deleting old files.
- Works on different platforms including Mac and PC servers. Also works with proxies and firewalls through the http protocol.
- Web-based reporting to view videos queued for downloading and videos already downloaded.
- Seamless to your end-users.
